SUPPLIER DEVELOPMENT AND LOCALISATION UNDERTAKING

Tenderers are required to make undertakings to advance designated groups through Local content, subcontracting, skills development commitments and job creation commitments.

The tenderer is required to complete this undertaking and to submit the completed form as a tender returnable to Eskom prior to contract award.

Eskom reserves the right to negotiate with the tenderer on these requirements. The outcome of the negotiations will be a contractual obligation. If negotiations are not required, the tenderer's SD&L undertaking will also become a contractual obligation.

1. Local Procurement Content.

Local Procurement Content" refers to value added in South Africa by South African resources. Where a single contract involves a combination of local and imported goods and/or services, the tender response must be separated into its components as per the Price Schedule included with the tender documents. Local procurement content is total spending minus the imported component.
