**SCOPE OF WORK:**  
**Provision of a Class A Facility**

Eskom Rotek Industries, Logistics Waste Management Services requires the services of a Landfill Site Classification of Class A, that can accept, treat and dispose of Hazardous waste ratings from I to IV, and is able to accept extreme risk and high risk waste streams generated, but also able to accept general waste streams. Compliance with Waste Classification and Management Regulations GN 636 (Government Notice), GN 634 (Government Notice) and GRN 635 (Government Regulatory Notice) is compulsory.

The landfill site must have the ability to accept, treat and dispose all waste streams, as per legislative requirements in a Class A licensing. Supplier who complies with the legal licensing requirements as stipulated will be considered. Waste will be disposed to the nearest available landfill site. Hazardous waste is generated in the following Provinces Free State, (FS) Limpopo, (LP) Gauteng (GP) and Mpumalanga Provinces (MP) for disposal at a Class A Facility(ties).

These services will be required as and when required for a duration of 3 years (36 months).

**Work Information**

ERI Logistics Waste Management Services has various contracts with internal and external clients for waste management services, which includes the disposal of hazardous waste. ERI is committed to only making use of facilities compliant to applicable legislation, regulations and company compliance requirements.

The vendor / facility will be required to provide containers for sampling of hazardous waste at no cost, analysis of waste streams, analysis reports, waste information sheets (indicating generator, applicable treatment, disposal method etc.) for waste streams and accurately and compliant legislative completed documentation (manifests signed off and stamped, safe disposal certificates identifying the Generator of the waste stream etc.). The facility is required to supply annual audit reports (external), all applicable licences and permits as and when renewed or updated, provide proof of reporting to applicable institutions (e.g. SAWIS (South African Waste Information System, Municipalities if required) and be able to provide compliant advice or guidance on best practices, methodologies etc. as and when required. Additionally, the facility must be able to do classification of waste according to SANS 10234, provide the classification reports and provide Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) for the waste streams classified.

The vendor / facility must be a Class A landfill site capable of treating and disposing of hazardous waste as per applicable legislation. All facilities must identify waste streams or hazardous waste not accepted.

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
